VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The climate is hot with high evaporation rates and generally low rainfall, making irrigation essential. The climate is also continental, resulting in long sunny days and noticeably cooler nights. Modern viticultural and winemaking techniques mean that the climate can be seen as one of the region's strengths. Long sunshine hours ensure fruit ripens fully and low relative humidity results in little incidence of disease.

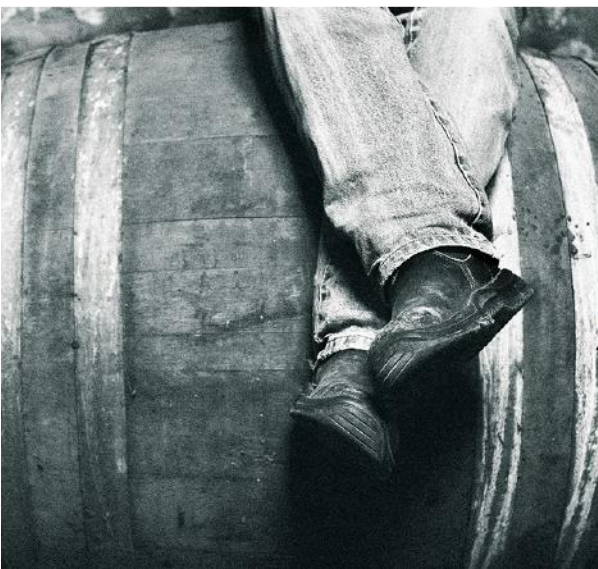
WINEMAKING

Australian shiraz has developed a name for itself on the international stage for producing high quality, distinctly varietal and bountiful wines. This wine is a perfect representation of that style.

The fruit for this wine was sourced from our vineyards in South Australia, Victoria and New South Wales. The parcels of fruit were treated individually fermented and matured, before being blended to create this outstanding wine.

TASTING NOTES

The McGuigan Black Label Shiraz is a well rounded and fruity wine featuring rich flavours of red fruits and chocolate. This is balanced with savoury leather and spicy oak aromas to result in a wine with good depth and intensity of flavour. A full rounded palate displaying generous red fruit flavours, soft tannins and acidity balanced by sweetness. Shiraz is a wonderful wine to couple with food and in particular succulent red meat dished and tomato based pasta.
