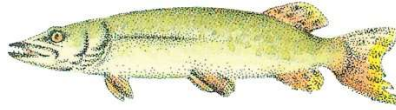


# PIKES

## 2015 “The Dogwalk” Cabernet Merlot

Appearance: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Attractive blackcurrant and red cherry aromas complemented by some dusty/cedary oak with flecks of tobacco and crushed violets. The oak is very much in the background as usual.

Palate: Medium bodied, displaying good concentration of blackcurrant and dark cherry, subtle French oak, balanced acidity and very fine tannins. Finishes long and with elegance.

Summary: Makes a nice drink right now for such a young wine, but it will take 7-10 years of cellaring easily. Veal cutlets would be a lovely dish to serve this wine with.

### TECHNICAL NOTES:

Alc/Vol 14.5%, 3.49 pH, 6.24 g/L TA.

100% Clare Valley GI, Estate grown fruit.

Closure: Screwcap.
