Complex, floral, light white fruits beginning, citrus aromas emerge after a while, white peach, white strawberry, red apple then grapefruit; moderate+ autolysis; intriguing. On the palate – crisp, dry, fresh and full of grapefruit, white peach and white strawberry flavours, plenty of fresh ripe acidity along with some moderate weight autolysis – this wine is a fine aperitif style with obvious complexity and finish, balanced and well made.
