Precise and beautifully detailed, this restrained Chablis shows delicate aromas of white stone fruit, lemon pith, flint and oatmeal on the nose. The palate offers excellent focus and linear mouthfeel, brilliantly structured by firm acidity, leading to a lingering crisp finish. Lovely poise and structure, should evolve beautifully. At its best: 2017 to 2022.

Bright, light straw-yellow colour with lemon-green hues, lighter on the rim. The nose is soft and gently full with aromas of white stonefruits interwoven with chalky minerals and subtle flint notes, the aromatics combining a delicate richness with a degree of mouthwatering freshness. Dry to taste and medium-bodied, the palate possesses light and fresh flavours of white and yellow stonefruits underlined by fine flint and mineral notes. The mouthfeel is soft and has a little richness with reserved, lacy acidity lending energy and balance, and the wine carries to a light, soft and dry finish. This is a soft, light dry Chablis 1er Cru with stonefruit, flint and mineral notes and a balanced palate. Serve as an aperitif and with seafood over the next 3 years. Hand-picked fruit from 'Fourchaume', fermented in tank to 12.5% alc., the wine aged 7-8 months in tank on lees.
