## Rosé 2014

- Region South Eastern Australia
- Colour Salmon pink
- Aroma Complex and sweet on the nose, full of cherry and blackcurrant flavours with a slight musk influence.
- Palate A light weight wine with beautiful fruit sweetness. Hints of ripe strawberry and sweet cherry lead to a refreshing, crisp finish.
- Food Serve well chilled, delicious on its own or as the perfect match to summer salads or quiche lorraine.
- Notes Provence is an iconic, picturesque region of rolling hills, medieval villages, fields of lavender and is also the spiritual home of French Rosé. This wine is made in the traditional Provencal style, using Sauvignon Blanc and Grenache, resulting in a Rosé that is full of sweetness but balanced with great acidity. The Grenache is used to extract maximum floral notes from the skins, while the Sauvignon Blanc provides the delicate acidity on the back of the palate.
- Drink while young and fresh.
