



2014 “The Dogwalk” Cabernet Merlot

Appearance: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Attractive aromas of blackcurrant and red cherry with some flecks of tobacco and crushed violets. The subtle, cedary French oak is very much in the background as usual.

Palate: A medium bodied palate displaying good concentration of red and dark fruits, balanced acidity and fine tannins.

Summary: Makes a nice drink right now for such a young wine, but it will take 3-5 years of cellaring easily. Veal cutlets would be a lovely dish to serve this wine with.

Alc/Vol 13.0%, 3.53 pH, 6.0 g/L TA.

100% Clare Valley GI, Estate grown fruit.
