



## 2012 “Red Mullet”

**Shiraz 64%, Tempranillo 21%, Grenache 9%, Mourvedre 6%**

Colour: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Enticing aromas of ripe black and red fruits including blueberry and cherry with hints of white pepper and a little mint.

Palate: The medium weight palate is soft, rich and juicy to the core with just enough tannin to give balance and add some texture and length.

Summary: Predominantly made from Shiraz with other bibs n bobs, the Red Mullet is a little more serious than the name suggests. While providing affordable every day drinking, this wine delivers plenty on the quality front. Drink now and over the next 3-5 years. Try it with beef braised in stout.
