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Gold Medal

Pale bronze with mahogany hues. Massive concentration of walnuts, figs, raisin and treacle on the nose. Lifted acidity keeps the taste fresh. The whold is round, smooth yet with superb lasting power on the finish.

### INTERNATIONAL WINE CHALLENGE

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Silver Medal

Dark amber lifted toffee, sea salt. Round, smooth and broad with hints of figs, dried fruit, walnut and orange peel. Long finish.

### DECANTER WORLD WINE AWARDS

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Silver Medal & 94 Points

Precise, textbook Oloroso, giving aromas of nuts, old wood, caramel, smoked meats, vanilla and caramel. The palate is long and harmonious, with a silky texture, Christmas spices and a saline finish.

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91 Points

Leans to the generous side, with a slightly off-dry mix of sesame, buckwheat and date flavors, though racy walnut and hazelnut husk elements hold sway through the finish.

Offers a flattering, off-dry edge up front, with notes of date and caramel caressing the core of bitter orange, singed almond and licorice root. Turns progressively firmer through the finish, featuring dried nectarine and toasted walnut accents. Drink now.
