Gloriously fresh and seductive, with delightful aromas of black tea, kumquats, chamomile and fresh grapes. Sweet raisin notes are lifted by black pepper spice, orange, smoke and a hint of dark chocolate bitterness on the palate. Orange pastilles and tangy sherbet linger on the finish.

Deep amber colour, rich honeyed caramel and dried fruit, specifically dates. Viscous on palate with hazelnut flavours.
