Crisp, dry and layered on the palate with flavours of wild raspberry and plum, a light white pepper spice and fine tannins. Balanced and well made. Drink now and through 2020.

A blend of merlot with smaller portions of pinot noir, syrah and cabernet. Full-flavoured rosé with summer berries, spice and plum flavours. Off-dry but with a pleasantly drying finish. A smooth-textured and appealing wine that offers good value at this price.

Very pale pink colour, light edged. The nose is fresh with aromas of strawberries and cream, the fruit with good ripeness, the componentry very harmoniously presented, and quite mouthwatering from the youthfulness. Dry to taste, the palate is elegant in proportion, quite taut with strawberries and cream, along with thirst-quenching bitter cherry notes and a touch of herbs. Very fine-textured, and lively, crisp acidity, finishing clean, dry and lightly nuanced with red fruits. All Martinborough fruit, a blend of 35% Syrah, 30% Merlot, 15% Pinot Noir and 10% Chardonnay, the Pinot Noir fermented in barrel, to 13.5% and dryness.
